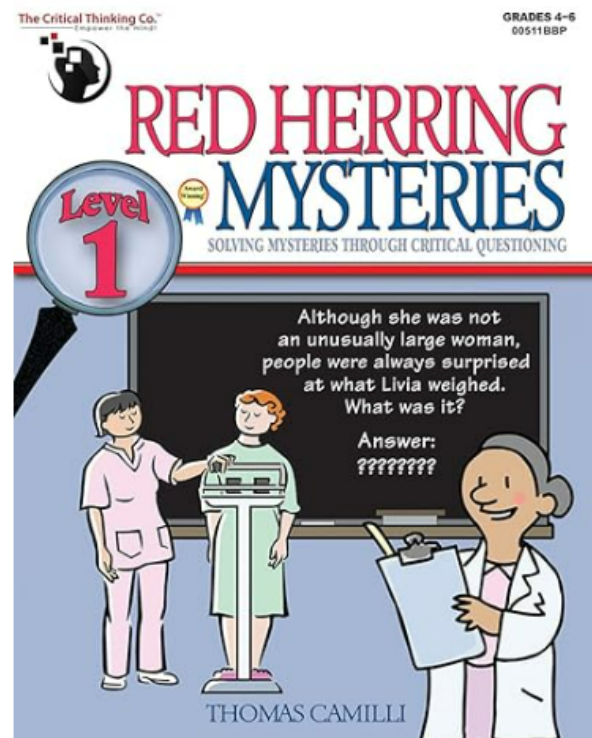
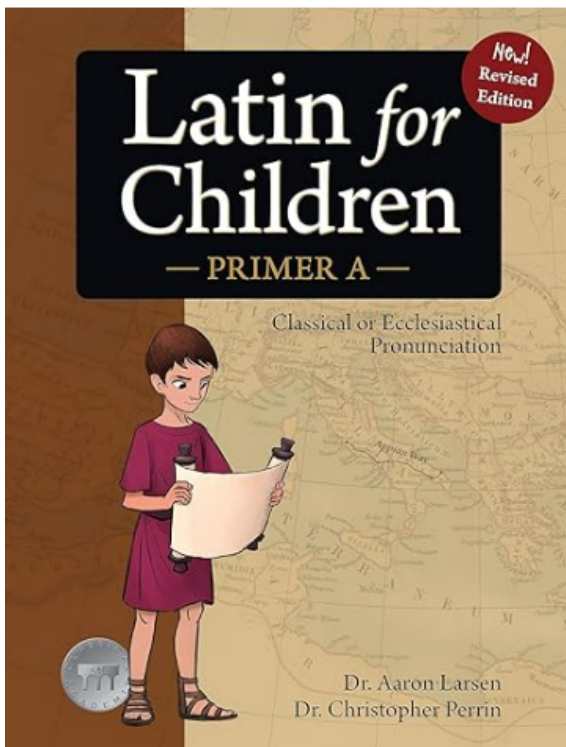


Exposition

 - Plenty of support & fun throughout the learning process.



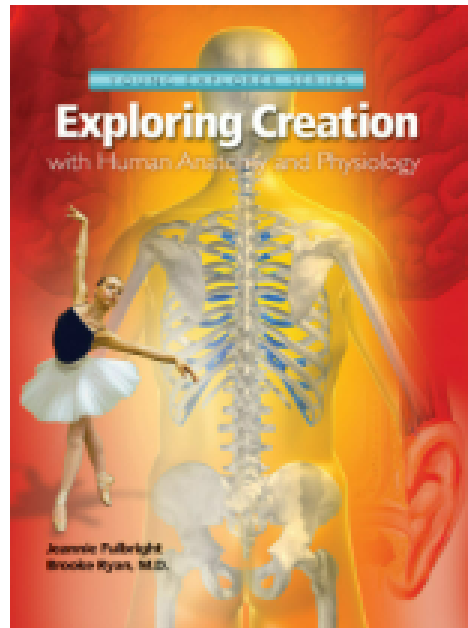

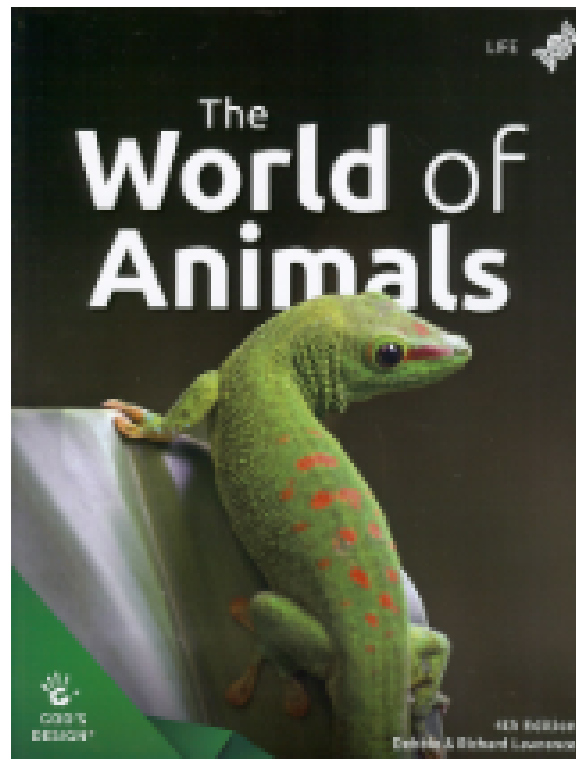


Logic

 - Develops critical thinking and clarity in writing and speaking.



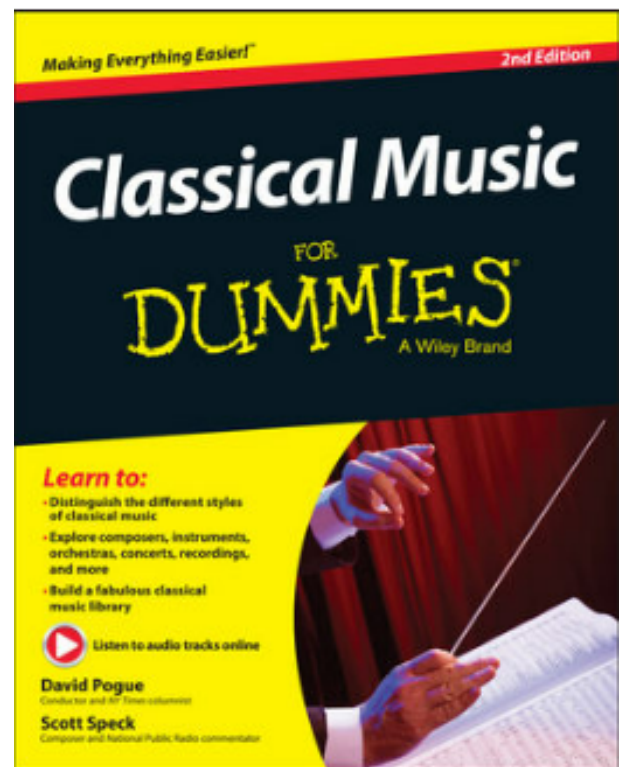

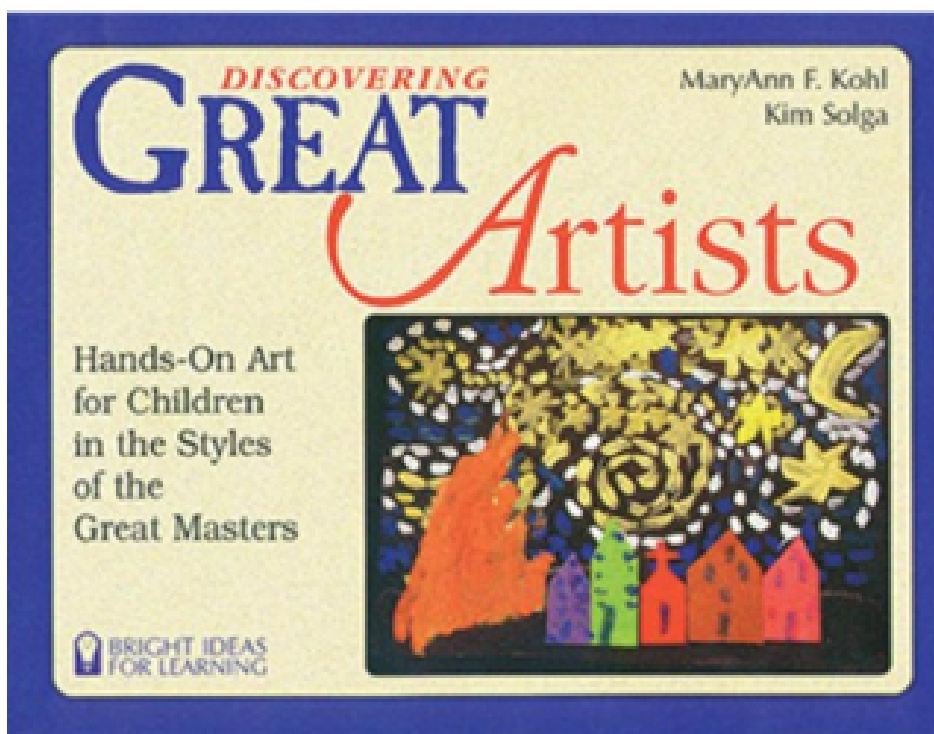


Science/Research
