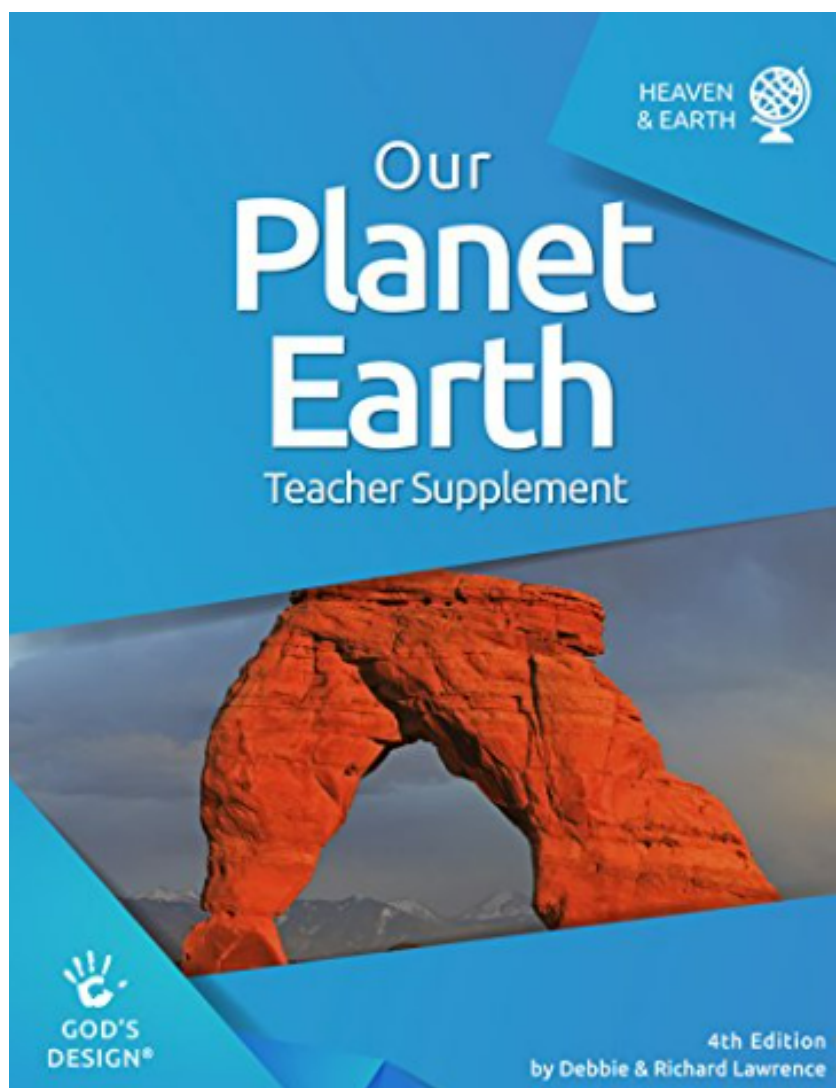
In the Logic subject, Grammar 2 students will gain the following:
